**R**obert Lee Grazier Sr., 87, of Pomfret, MD, passed away suddenly on August 10, 2016.

Born on Aug. 27, 1928 in Edwardsville, IL, he was the son of the late George Henry Grazier and the late May Briddick. Known to his friends as Bob, he worked in the automotive radiator repair business and owned Camp Springs Radiator Service for 28 years before retiring in 1985. 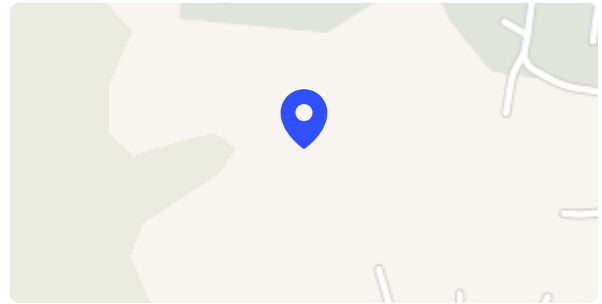
