**L**ouis David Curry, 85, of White Plains, Maryland, passed away on Thursday, October 29, 2020 at Sage Point Senior Living in La Plata, Maryland.

Born on February 8, 1935 in Pleasureville, Kentucky, he was the son of the late Houston Luther Curry and Hallie Curry. Lou served in the U. S. Army until he was Honorably Discharge in 1957. Having a Master's Degree in History, Lou worked as a Supervisor Archivist for the National Archives mainly declassifying Classified documents until retiring after 24 years of service. 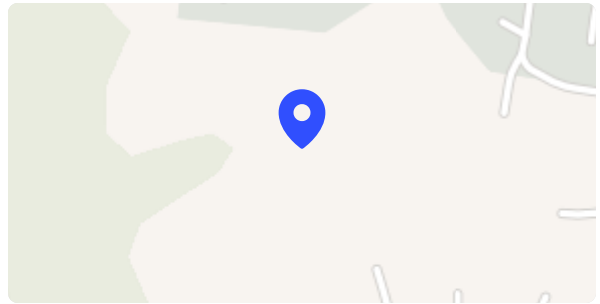
