**A**nna Mae (Lynn) Sackie, 94, of La Plata, MD died Sunday, June 4, 2023, at home with family at her side. She was a retired hairdresser, owner/operator of Anna Mae's Beauty Shop, for over 50 years out of her home. She was a very kind, loving soul to all she knew.

Born March 23, 1929 and raised in Indian Head, MD, she attended Lackey High School and enjoyed the sports of playing basketball and baseball and after she graduated spent several years afterwards organizing the Lackey class reunions. After graduation she attended Towson University to become a teacher then decided to go to beauty school in D.C. to become a hairdresser. 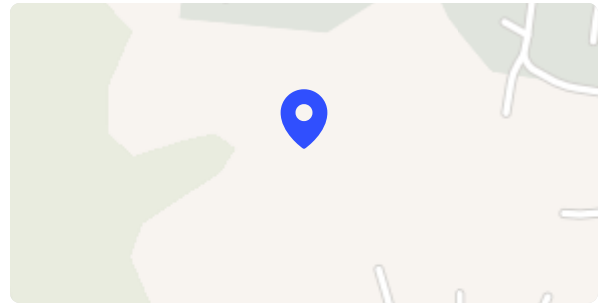
