Mary “Frances” Lewis, 97, formerly of La Plata, Maryland departed this life on October 16, 2023 in her home in Okatie, South Carolina.

Frances, beloved mother, grandmother, and great grandmother is survived by her two children; Gregory A. Lewis and Susanne L. Wills, two grandchildren; Evan C. Lewis and Jessica A. Hensel, three great grandchildren; Seth Lewis, Paige A. Sanders and Cole Lewis, and her brother David W. Lasseter. Frances was predeceased by her husband Clifton F. 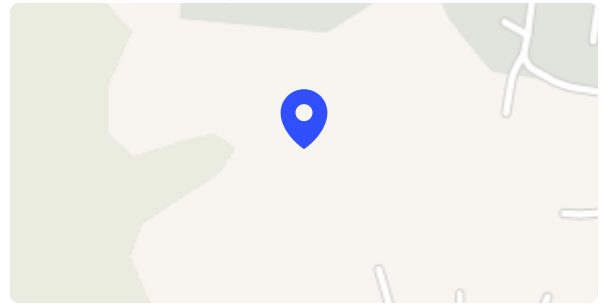
