Daniel Howard Murphy, of Fredericksburg, passed away peacefully on December 23, 2025, at the age of 86. He was born on September 10, 1939, in Dentsville, Maryland, to the late William and Lillian Murphy.

One of fifteen children, Daniel grew up in a large family and shared a particularly special bond with his twin brother, David. Family was always at the center of Daniel's life, shaping the quiet strength, loyalty, and warmth for which he was known.

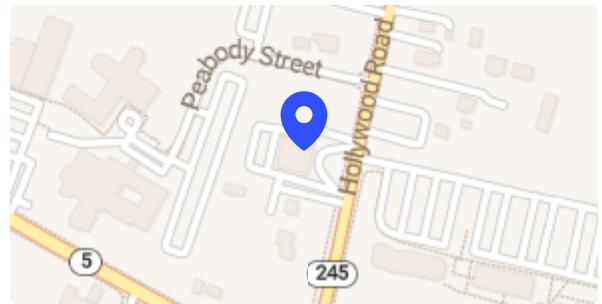

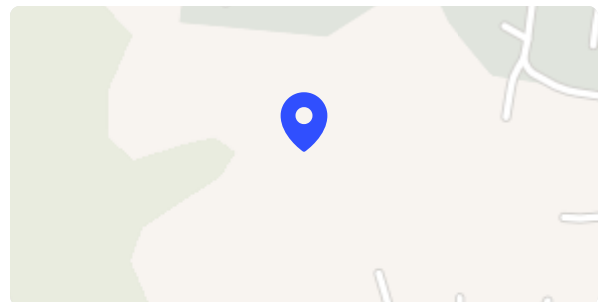

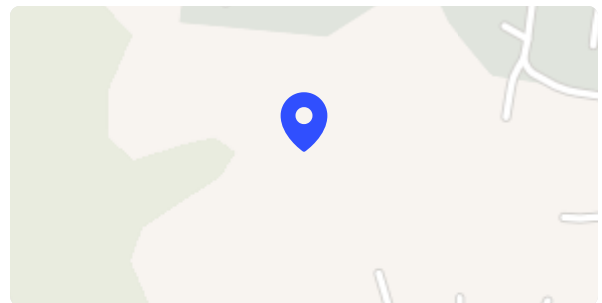
