Dorothy Lorraine Bowie "Sissy" Maddox, 90, of LaPlata, Maryland passed away on Monday, January 19, 2026, after a lengthy battle with metastatic breast cancer. She was born during a snow storm on December 30, 1935, delivered by one of her sisters in their home in Pisgah, Maryland. She was a life-long resident of Charles County Maryland. She was a wife, mother, sister, grandmother (affectionately called "GaGa" by her grands), friend and a member of Pisgah United Methodist Church where she enjoyed fellowship and serving others in the name of the Lord. She worked for the Federal Government, where she began her career as a clerk typist in 1956 and worked her way up the ranks, retiring as a Contracting Officer from the U.S. Navy in Indian Head, Maryland in 1990. 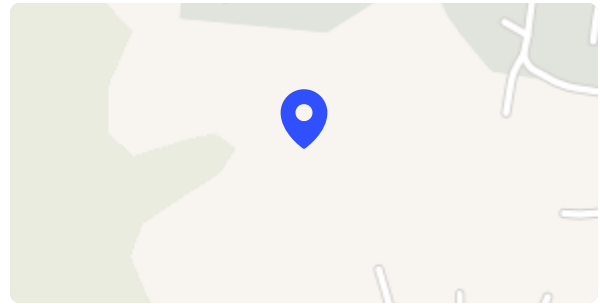

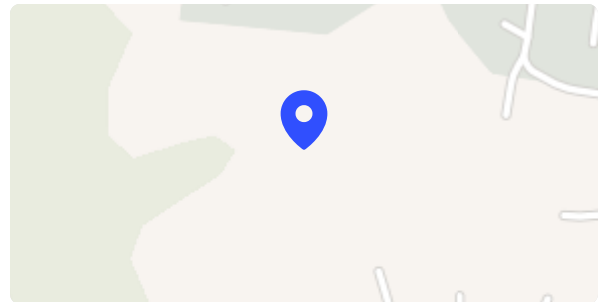

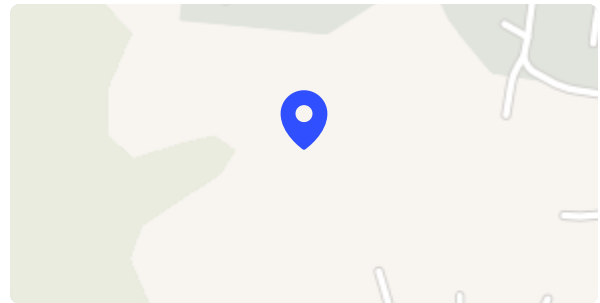
